## Parish News

**First Weekend Second Collection** is today at all the Masses. This collection is for parish expenses. 100% of this collection stays in the parish. Thank you for your continued support.

**The Feast of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary is on August 15th.** It is not a holy day of obligation this year. However, Fr. Mulrone will offer a Traditional Latin Mass at 6:30 PM.

**Beginning in September,** we will pray the rosary before the Saturday Vigil Mass, and on Sundays before the 9:00am Mass and before low Latin Masses at 1:00pm. Please arrive at least 20 minutes before Mass. Any men of the parish willing to lead the rosary, please sign up on the sheet at the back of the church.

**Registration for First Holy Communion and Confirmation Classes** will be after all the Masses on August 20th and 21st. First Communion is a 2 year class which begins in First grade. Confirmation is also a 2 year class and you must be 13 by October 1st to join. Registration fees are \$40 per student, but there will be an early registration discount and if fees are paid before September 18 and the cost will be \$30 per student. If you are registering for the first year of either the First Communion Class or the Confirmation Class, please bring a copy of your baptismal certificate.

### SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM
