## Prayer Chain

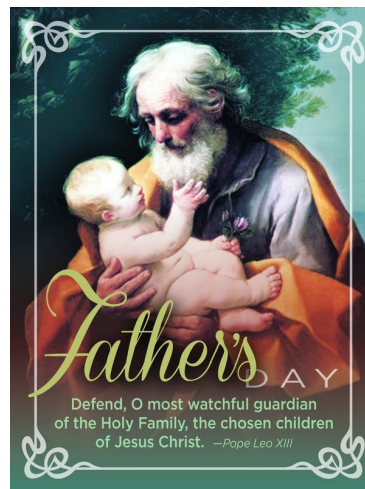
If you or someone you know is in need of prayer, please call our Parish Secretary, Jan Rebman, and request to be included in the parish Prayer Chain.
