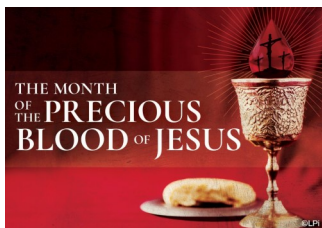
Prayer Chain
